

## Primary School Sports Funding Expenditure Report 2017/18

### Funding received

**Total amount of Sports funding received**

**£21,140**

### Nature of support

Funding has been allocated to the following areas:

**Staff Professional Development, Intra/Inter-School competition**

- School Sports Partnership SLA = Entry to Darlington SSP competitions and festivals, PE network access, School Games day, CPD & regional PE conference, Extra-curricular Dance clubs, coaching support.
- Access to local competitions = Money set aside for staff release and transport.

**Curriculum enhancement**

- Wheel Education SLA = Provision of cycling and scooter training as part of PE curriculum

**Extra-curricular offer**

- Extra-curricular sports clubs staffing costs = (5 hours per week Out of Hours Assistant support and Dance Coach) – to support extra-curricular provision for gymnastics and dance.

**Sports and Active Play Equipment**

- Purchase of sporting equipment including trim trails (Key Stage 1 & 2 playground) and football goal posts.

### Measuring the impact of Sports Funding spending

Impact will be measured in each area through:

**Staff Professional Development, Intra/Inter-School competition**

- The number of competitions and festivals attended and the number of pupils who access these events.
- The number of Year 1,2,5,6 pupils accessing dance clubs across the academic year.

**Curriculum enhancement**

- Pupil outcomes in PE indicated by end of year teacher assessments.

**Extension of extra-curricular offer**

- The number of pupils accessing extra-curricular sports clubs across the academic year.

**Sports and active play equipment**

- The number of pupils with access to active play equipment for 30 minutes daily physical activity.
- The number of pupils with access to extra-curricular football and inter-school football competition.

### Outcomes

The impact of Sports Funding spending during the academic year was:

**Staff Professional Development, Intra/Inter-School competition**

422 pupils accessed 27 competitions and festivals across the academic year.

40 pupils accessed Year 1/2 & Year 5/6 dance clubs across the academic year.

**Curriculum enhancement**

65% of pupils were working at Expectation+ in PE by the end of the academic year.

**Extra-curricular offer**

30 pupils accessed gymnastics club across the academic year.

30 pupils accessed Year 3/4 dance club across the academic year.

**Sports and active play equipment**

566 pupils had access to 30 minutes daily physical activity.

110 pupils accessed extra-curricular football and inter-school football competition.
